VICC Board Extends Enrollment of New Transfer Students
Extension Unanimously Approved at Special October 19 Meeting

The extension was unanimously approved by the VICC Board of Directors on Friday, October 19, 2012. As a result, districts currently accepting new students into the St. Louis Student Transfer Program and expected to continue to do so under the new enrollment extension, as space limitations allow them to do so, are as follows:

Students living in the above named suburban school districts, plus those who live in Ritenour, and meet eligibility criteria, will continue to be eligible to apply to transfer into the St. Louis Magnet Schools.
